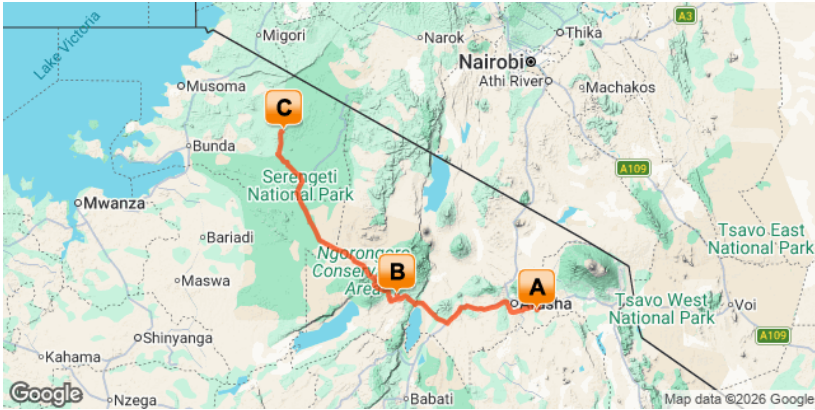

## Day 1: Hamerkop House by Lemala, The Kilimanjaro Golf and Wildlife Estate

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### Day Itinerary

Upon arrival at Kilimanjaro Airport, your guide will welcome you and provide a comfortable air-conditioned vehicle, bottled water, and a cool towel. The transfer time to Kahawa House and Arusha Coffee Lodge is roughly 90 minutes, or 60 minutes to Hamerkop House. During the transfer, you can chat with your driver about the local surroundings and enjoy sights of the bustling and colourful town of Arusha.

Once you arrive, you can relax by the pool with a cold drink and a good book or get a massage to relieve post-flight tension. In-house dining at all options offers a wide selection of local and international cuisine, ensuring all taste preferences are satisfied before you turn in for a good night's sleep.



The name Tanzania conjures up images of wildebeest stampeding across vast savannah, rain forests teeming with monkeys and birdlife, and great plains brimming with legions of game. All of these natural wonders and more are on offer in this exceptionally diverse African nation. Visitors typically visit Tanzania to partake in at least one of the four well-known Tanzanian tourist experiences: a relaxing seaside vacation on the picturesque island paradise of Zanzibar, an underwater tour of some of the world's most renowned dive sites around the gorgeous Spice Islands, a safari adventure in some of Africa's most impressive game reserves, or a hiking excursion around Mount Kilimanjaro National Park. Whichever of these incredible holidays you choose, you will undoubtedly be welcomed by some fabulously friendly and peaceful inhabitants who, despite being divided into 120 different ethnic groups and cultures, live in harmony with one another and provide some of the most wonderfully exotic local cuisine you could imagine. With all of this diversity on offer, the most difficult part of your Tanzanian holiday experience is likely to be deciding where to go!

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Tucked between Mt Kilimanjaro and Mt Meru, the Kilimanjaro Golf and Wildlife Estate comprises an 18-hole championship golf course together with a real estate development set within an area of outstanding natural beauty. The estate is situated on over 400 hectares of African bush, approximately 25 kilometres from the tourism stopover

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### **Overnight: Hamerkop House by Lemala**

This beautiful private house is managed exclusively by Lemala Camps and Lodges. This private house is located on a wildlife and golf estate, Kiligolf, situated halfway between Kilimanjaro International Airport and Arusha, and offers a great place to start or finish your safari. It is perfect for couples, families or small groups travelling together. Each bedroom is en suite with a private verandah and lounge. The house can be taken on a private exclusive use basis or shared and can be booked on full board or all-inclusive basis.

Arusha is the gateway to some of Tanzania's best national parks, and Hamerkop House a great way to recover from the rigours of your journey to Africa – or to sit and reminisce on your adventures before starting your journey home, start your safari experience. Access to Tanzania's only championship golf course means guests can enjoy a relaxing and incredibly scenic round under the shadow of both Mount Meru and Kilimanjaro.




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### **Alternate: Elewana Arusha Coffee Lodge**

Located in the middle of a verdant coffee plantation, Elewana Arusha Coffee Lodge is a sanctuary of aromatic tranquility and a welcome retreat after a long international flight, or the dust and excitement of a thrilling bush safari.

Take residence in one of 30 luxury wooden chalets - 12 Plantation Suites and 18 Plantation Rooms - nestled amongst the surrounding gardens and sea of coffee trees.

Turning off the road, a tree-lined drive guides you to the warm and inviting main area with its quiet understated aura of luxury. Vibrant gardens, a spa, and a swimming pool await, and a restaurant, Bacchus, and café bistro, 3° South, boast menus to satisfy the most discerning of palates, successfully fusing international culinary prowess with locally-sourced ingredients.



**Alternate: Kahawa House**

A homely lodge situated in a suburban area in northern Tanzania, Kahawa House is located in Arusha, 6km southwest of the centre of town. The accommodation provides convenient access to Arusha Domestic Airport and is an ideal rest stop for visitors to Arusha National Park. Facilities include a swimming pool as well as a deck where guests can enjoy lunch and dinner.

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## Day 2: Kitela Lodge, Karatu

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### Day Itinerary

In the Comfort and Classic options, your driver-guide will meet you after breakfast as you begin the driving portion of your safari. As you leave Arusha behind, you'll head west, passing small settlements and watching bicycles carrying large bunches of bananas as you pass through the small town of Mto wa Mbu. A game drive through Lake Manyara National Park will immediately immerse you in Tanzania's bush and wildlife. The park is centred around a large alkaline lake, which attracts a variety of birdlife all year round, including greater and lesser pink flamingo between November and April, as well as pelican, stork and heron. Hippo, lion, elephant, giraffe, buffalo, zebra, and wildebeest can be seen on the grassy plains and among the acacia woodlands. Enjoy a delightful picnic lunch in the shade before continuing your journey towards Ngorongoro. From here, the road begins to ascend, and the elevation changes as you climb the steep walls of the Great Rift Valley before arriving in Karatu.

In the Reserve option, you'll be met by your driver after breakfast and transferred to Arusha Airport for your short flight to Lake Manyara Airstrip. On arrival, a guide from Neptune Ngorongoro Lodge will be on hand to welcome you, and transfer you into the town of Karatu.

This bustling town lies in the shadow of the Ngorongoro Crater and is surrounded by beautiful, lush farmlands. Ngorongoro Farmhouse, Kitela Lodge and Neptune Ngorongoro are all situated amidst beautiful gardens and surrounded by coffee plantations, offering a tranquil environment to unwind while enjoying fresh, home-grown produce. Located conveniently close to the entry gate to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, these lodges are perfect for an early morning start to avoid the queue at the park gate.



Travellers heading for the Serengeti and Ngorongoro Crater will pass through the town of Karatu in the green hills of Tanzania's northern highlands. Presided over by the towering Ol Deani Volcano, this small, colourful town serves as a popular overnight stop for visitors exploring the area's many game parks. The town offers a variety of activities including browsing the bustling marketplace, sampling beer at a local brewery, visiting a traditional homestead, or taking a guided walk through the Ngorongoro Forest in search of waterfalls and caves. Whether you are looking for cultural tours, hiking and biking opportunities, a chance to enjoy an authentic rural Tanzania experience, or simply a break between safari game drives, this underrated town has plenty to offer.

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### Overnight: Kitela Lodge

Kitela Lodge is a small, exclusive lodge situated on top of a valley overlooking a coffee plantation, the Eastern wall of the Ngorongoro crater and a beautiful waterfall. It consists of 20 spacious suites in cottages built in the style of an old colonial farm offering guests a relaxing, quiet atmosphere surrounded by beautiful gardens. Includes pool and massage treatment cabins.

Kitela Spa offers guests simplicity, respect for local traditions and sustainable ecology in a perfect African setting. Stimulate your senses and enjoy the ultimate indulgence in our spa. Kitela Spa offers a selection of treatments for the sheer bliss of relaxing the body, mind and soul.



**Alternate: Ngorongoro Farm House**

Ngorongoro Farmhouse Lodge is situated beneath the majestic Oldeani Volcano, and boasts easy access to both the untamed wilderness of Ngorongoro Conservation Area, as well as the simple pleasure of a ramble through 500 acres of farmland.

Ngorongoro Farm House was inaugurated on February 20th 2003, and is offering 52 room cottages, 49 standard rooms and 3 suite rooms, all with ample space inside, built on the style of an old colonial farm and rustically decorated with local materials and full of details of good taste, with the purpose of offering our clients an imaginary journey to the life of the days gone.



**Alternate: Neptune Ngorongoro Lodge**

Set in 50 acres of virgin Tanzanian bush in the Ngorongoro volcanic landscape, this all suites wood log cabin style retreat is located a few steps from the Game Reserve Gate and 20 minutes drive away from the Ngorongoro Crater that is said to have the most dense concentration of wildlife in Africa.

This all inclusive property features 20 spacious private log cabins with fire place, a restaurant, a bar and conference facilities. Indulge in moments of relaxation at the swimming pool or at the Mvua African Rain Spa after a full-day game drive.

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**Day 3: Kitela Lodge, Karatu**

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**Day Itinerary**

It's an early start to the day as you aim to be amongst the first vehicles into the Ngorongoro Conservation Area and onto the crater floor. After passing through the entry gate, the steep road ascends the outer slopes of the Ngorongoro Crater through a lush and dense forest until you arrive on the crater rim road with a spectacular viewing point of the crater. Marvel at this UNESCO World Heritage Site and take a photograph before continuing on your journey.

Once you descend to the crater floor, there's time for coffee and some breakfast snacks to see you through the morning's adventure on safari. The Ngorongoro Crater is a unique safari destination, home to black rhino, lion, leopard, hippo and more. To game drive in the base of a dormant volcano is not something you will soon forget. By mid-afternoon, it'll be time to start the return journey up the caldera's walls to the rim and onward to the welcome comfort of your lodge. Unwind with a massage, or simply relax at your suite before drinks and dinner in the dining room, sharing safari stories with fellow travellers.

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## Day 4-6: Pamoja Migration Camp, Northern Serengeti

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### Day Itinerary

After a delicious breakfast, it's time to retrace your steps out of Karatu as you head towards Manyara Airstrip on the edge of the escarpment. From here, you say goodbye to your driver-guide and board a plane to your mobile camp in the north or south of the Serengeti (depending on the season). On arrival at the airstrip, your guide will meet you and transfer you to camp, arriving in time for lunch.

In the early afternoon, settle into your new surroundings and enjoy the views from your veranda. The early afternoon hours can be the hottest, making it an excellent time to relax in the shade with a book and a cool drink. As the afternoon drifts, there's a chance for a cup of tea or coffee and a sweet treat before heading out for an afternoon game drive across the endless plains of the Serengeti. Home to an abundance of wildlife, including big cats, elephant herds, meandering zebra and of course the Great Migration, there is much to discover here. As sunset approaches, there may be time for a sundowner in a scenic spot. Return to camp for the chance to freshen up and relax with a drink by the fireside beneath the sparkling stars before dinner.

Game drives in shared vehicles typically go out twice daily in the early morning and late afternoon. Depending on the other adventurers, you can take a picnic lunch and spend a whole day out on safari to cover greater distances in one day. Alternatively, consider hiring a private vehicle for your stay to have complete freedom of choice regarding how your day is structured. If you have very particular wildlife interests, this is really worthwhile, allowing you to spend as long as you like at wildlife sightings and set the pace you choose with your guide. For a different perspective, consider a hot air balloon safari and take to the skies for a genuinely unforgettable sunrise experience.



Located between the Central Serengeti and Kenya's Masai Mara National Reserve to the north, the Northern Serengeti is a remote African wildlife wonderland. The vast, rolling savannah of the Northern Serengeti, is known as the hub of the great migration. The landscape is characterised by vast stretches of savannah interspersed with acacia trees and riverine woodlands. Wildlife can be seen along the banks of the Mara River and visitors can view the annual spectacle of the half a million migrating wildebeest. Commonly spotted wildlife include: a multitude of plains game such as buffalo, zebra, gazelles, impala, giraffe as well as lion and leopard. Visitors can look forward to bird watching, hot air ballooning, game safaris and guided bush walks.

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### Overnight: Pamoja Migration Camp

Pamoja Migration Camp is a mobile camp that follows in the footsteps of the Great Migration. Every year it moves from December to April to allow guests to experience the beauty and spectacle of the wildebeest migration in the Southern Serengeti. From June to October, Pamoja Migration Camp moves back up north towards the Mara River crossing area of the Northern Serengeti to be at the epicentre of the Migration. Guests can experience the incredible sights and sounds of thousands of wildebeest migrating across vast open plains in search of fresh grass and water. Pamoja Migration Camp provides an exclusive safari experience that will leave guests with lasting memories.
